

BREAKOMATON.

INTERACTIVE CHOREOGRAPHIC INSTALLATION

The Breakomaton is an interactive digital street or indoor installation, which takes the form of a large dance booth housed on a trailer (or installed under a tent, in a dedicated room).

Participants who enter the installation meet digital teachers presented in the form of video avatars who will guide them in the creation of a short choreographic phrase. Accessible to all, participants discover the different techniques of breakdancing to create a music video clip.

The choreographies produced are then put together to form a video clip which will be sent to the participants' phones at the end of the activity.

FUNCTIONING

For 3 hours, the public parades through the installation to participate in the recording of a collective choreography. Inside the cabin, you will discover two virtual teachers who will guide you in performing a dance step.

Then, it's time for freestyle : the freestyle wheel randomly chooses music to which you will have the opportunity to bring out the dancer in you by improvising dance steps for 30 seconds.

From a screen placed outside the booth, the public can follow the construction of the work and encourage the daring candidates. Participants can also interact with the external audience. The cabin offers them an opportunity to put themselves on display while having fun.
